There are three groups of moving elements: Group A - Thorax, Pelvis, and Head. These elements create the basis for the pose; Group B - Upper limb and Lower limb. Supports the movement and balances the posture; Group C - Eyes, Mouth, Hand, Fingers, Foot, Toes. These little elements complete the composition.

The Takeaway: Use an anatomy book to understand what's below the surface but think about each muscle in 3D. Don't draw the muscles as a series of lines. Draw them as sculpted spheres, boxes and cylinders.
